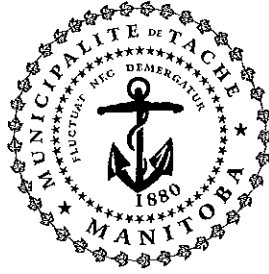

## **NO SCAVENGING POLICY**

### **1. Intent –**

This policy shall come into effect the date of Council's approving resolution. This policy will control the practice of scavenging and salvage at all Municipal waste management sites. This policy applies to the Monominto Transfer Station, the Taché Solid Waste Management Facility and any future waste management locations that may be developed. No scavenging or salvage of material deposited at a waste management facility shall be permitted, unless under written agreement with the Municipality. This policy applies to employees of the Municipality and members of the public. This policy conforms to accepted practices in landfill management and environmental licenses issued by the Province of Manitoba which regulate the operation of the above mentioned facilities.

### **2. Elements of Compliance**

- Employees shall not scavenge or salvage material at either waste management location.
- Waste management attendants are responsible to inform ratepayers that scavenging or salvaging is not a permitted activity, should they be aware of a ratepayer engaged in such activity.
- Salvaging of material shall only be allowed under a written agreement approved by Council. Such agreement shall define the limitations and terms on how salvage may be carried out.

### **3. Enforcement of Policy**

- Employees found to be engaged in scavenging or salvage will be subject to the disciplinary process.
- Council's discretion shall be applied to resolving an issue with a ratepayer found to be non-compliant with this policy.
