development setback distance and structure location within the lot to allow for riverbank erosion and/or instability over the ensuing

50 year period.

Water Stewardship: Requires the following before the lots are

developed:

1) An engineered drainage plan, as per the

attached specifications

2) The establishment of adequate flood

protection measures/levels.
